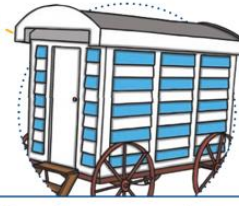
Communication and Language

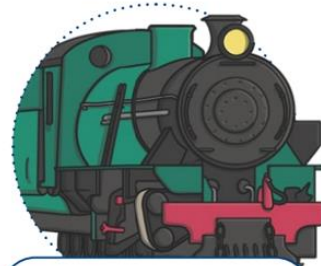

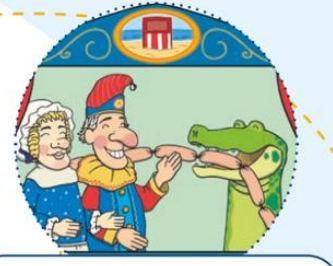

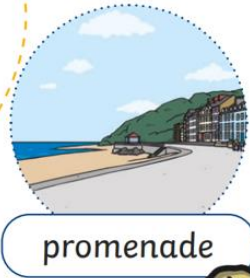
