1. The Return of the Potatoes!

2. Reading Eggs Competition.

Celebrate World Book Day 2021 with the Reading Eggs Story Factory competition. It will give students the opportunity to practise their writing skills and unleash their creativity! The story Factory is always open but for World Book Day (WBD) there is a special prize for the winning student's school! In order to get involved students must visit the Story Factory through Reading Eggs between 26th February to 4th March. Once in the Story Factory, students can create their own story books, using an easy step-by-step guide, based on a 'Baby Dinosaurs' theme. To be entered into the special World Book Day competition, the student must add 'WBD' to the end of their story title. The top stories are shortlisted and displayed in the Story Showroom during the following week. Fellow students can then read and rate the stories. The story with the highest average rating at the end of the week is the winner!
