Key Tier 2 Vocabulary:

Map	A representation of an area of land or sea showing physical features, cities, roads, etc.
Atlas	a book of maps or charts.
Continent	A continent is a large solid area of land . Earth has seven continents.
Country	A country is land that is controlled by a single government .
Ocean	An ocean is a huge body of salt water .

Key Tier 3 Vocabulary:

Brighton	Brighton is a seaside resort and one of the two main areas of the City of Brighton and Hove.
England	England is a country that is part of the United Kingdom. It shares land borders with Wales to its west and Scotland to its north
United Kingdom	The United Kingdom, made up of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland, is an island nation in northwestern Europe.
Africa	Africa is the world's second largest continent . More than 50 countries make up the continent.
Human features	Human features have been built by people . These include things like: houses, roads, city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour and shop.
Physical features	Physical features exist in the natural environment , such as climate, soil, natural vegetation, animal life, seas, mountains and rivers.
