



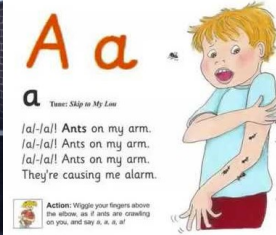
Music Round Up Autumn 1



The children are learning to listen, appraise, compose & perform music using voice, tuned & un-tuned instruments, plus body percussion. They have also had the opportunity to practice and explore music independently in continuous provision.

Reception

Reception use music and rhyme in many of their daily routines and as part of the explicit learning in phonics singing 'Ants on your arms!' They have been exploring their auditory capabilities with games and singing songs about 'being me' as a whole year group.



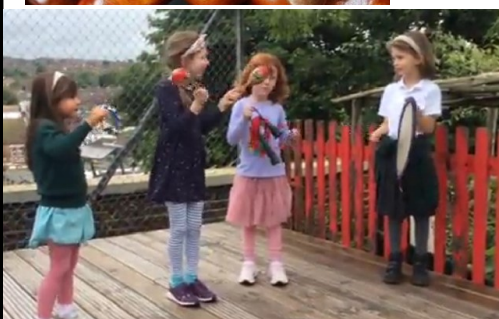
Year 1

Year 1 have been exploring a tuned instrument this term, learning to keep the beat with a 'chime bar'. They have also sang the song 'Hey you!' In the Woodland children have composed their own music using an array of percussion instruments and in class they have explored the *chrome music lab*.

Year 2

Year 2 have been learning about South African music focused around one song: Hands, Feet, Heart. singing and playing instruments, as well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song. They have carried this exploration into continuous provision.



Whole School

The whole school have been focussing on joyful and uplifting songs that bring us together. Year 1 and 2 have been singing 'Unstoppable' and 'Love is our guide', and Reception have been celebrating what it means to 'be me'. In addition all the year groups have celebrated the season with Autumnal classics such as 'Conkers'.
