



Our RE learning follows the locally agreed syllabus, using Discovery RE for our lesson plans. Most of the curriculum covers Christianity and Judaism, and particularly in Reception, we also look at celebrations and festivals from other faiths. We try to help children understand religious and non religious world views and how this affects how people live their lives.

Reception

Reception cover RE through their area of learning of 'Understanding the World'. During Spring and Summer they have learned about Chinese New Year, Holi and also looked at what we can learn from stories which helps them understand the role of religious texts.



Year 1

Year 1 have most recently been learning about Shabbat. They linked this to their own experiences of special days and special meals, as well as learning about the foods, rituals and symbolism of Shabbat and what they mean to Jews.





Year 2 have been learning about the Jewish Covenant. They linked this to their own experiences of promises and agreements with friends.





Although our curriculum is weighted towards Christianity and Judaism in KS1, we enjoy hearing about all children's experiences and world views, whether these are religious or not. Our assemblies promote our values which overlap with many of the teachings of the world's religions.
