## One morel one less

-Verbally (to begin) "One more than 13 is 14 . One less than 13 is $12 . "$

Look at number line - pointing to one more one less


## Pictorial Addition

$2+3=$

At a party, I eat 2 cakes and my friend eats 3.
How many cakes did we eat altogether?


Children may draw a picture to help them work out the answer

## Symbolic Addition

## $7+4=$

7 people are on the bus. 4 more get on at the next stop. How many people are on the bus


Children use dots or symbols to represent objects (quicker than drawing a picture)
Number line (Single jumps)
$5+3=$


Count On
Children use a number line to record jumps made. Use single jumps.
Bridging through 10


Add 9 (adjusting) $7+9=$


Jump forward 10 and then jump back 1.


Children use a ten frame to support adding by making ten first.
