Children have shown they understand how to be kind, and have really taken on board the messages of 'Anti-Bullying Week'.

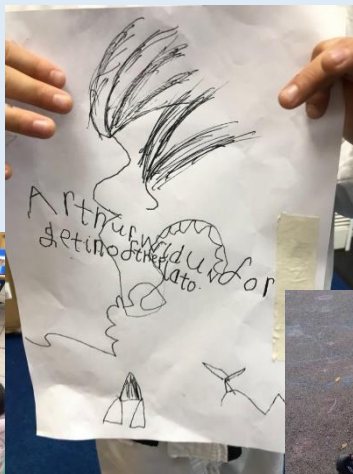

Reception have been learning about nursery rhymes, playing with big maths equipment, and learning the phonemes y and z. Year 1 have been learning about traditional tales and exploring parts of the story of the Three Billy Goats Gruff building bridges in the woodland.
