



Dear Parent/Carers,

ROBINWOOD 8th – 10th May 2024

Final arrangements and details for Wednesday!

Please arrive at school around 9.00am and accompany your child into school with their luggage. We will depart for Wrexham at approximately 9.30am. Please make sure that you do not block the entrance to school grounds as this is required for the coach.

The children need to wear comfortable footwear (walking boots or trainers), a jumper and a waterproof coat. If your child has an inhaler, please make sure it is in their coat pocket and please put any sun cream on your child before coming to school. Please note, we do have Factor 30 sun cream for use at Robinwood, but you may send your child in with their own bottle for use during our stay if you wish.

If your child needs to have travel sickness medication before the journey, please ensure that this is administered before they leave home. Any medication, including travel sickness pills for the return journey, must be handed to Mrs Minton who will be waiting for you in the Upper School entrance. Medication may be brought into school, in advance, on Friday 3rd May or Tuesday 7th May after school.

When you arrive at the hall, you need to report to your child's adult leader who will give you a luggage label that must be attached firmly to your child's luggage. The children will then need help to take their luggage out to the coach at the appropriate time with a member of Dowson staff. We will post a notice on the school website, Facebook page and around school of our safe arrival at Wrexham.

We hope to be back at school for approximately 2.50pm on Friday, a text message will be sent to you when the children are approximately 10 minutes away and updates will be posted on our Facebook page. The following number is to be used in an emergency.
