



Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our World War 2 History Topic, we are taking Year 6 on a trip to the Air Raid Shelters in Stockport on Friday 3rd March. During the trip, the children will get to experience what life was like during WW2 and how people lived during this time.

In order for the children to become fully immersed in the trip and the topic, we are asking them to come dressed as if they were an evacuee. We are aware that not everyone has the resources for full costume, but 1940s appropriate outfits can be made from clothes most children will already have in their wardrobe.

Ideas for girls: Cotton dress or school pinafore, Blouse and skirt (could be school skirt) Knitted cardigans, Hair in plaits or with a ribbon headband

Ideas for boys: Shirt, Balaclava, Knitted pullover, Short trousers (could be school shorts) School trousers, Fair-isle tank top.

The children will need a packed lunch that day. We would request all parents complete the link below to advise us whether you will be providing them with a packed lunch or require a school grab bag.
