## **Heading into Autumn/Winter**

## **SBC New Fining Process**

If you wish to take your child out of school during term time, please complete a pink request form available from the main school office. Please note that school attendance is a legal requirement for all statutory school-aged children. Any unauthorised absence may result in a fine issued by Swindon Borough Council:

- 1st Fine: £160 per child, per parent. Will reduce to £80 if paid within 21 days.
- 2nd Fine (with in 3 years of your first fine): £160 per child, per parent. This is a flat rate and will not reduce.
- 3rd Fine cannot be issues and will processed to alternative legal action

## **Attendance Meetings**

If your child's attendance falls below a certain percentage, you will receive an attendance letter to make you aware.

If attendance does not improve, you will be invited to meet with Mrs Phillips (Attendance Lead) to discuss any concerns and, if needed, create an action plan to support your child's attendance.

Should attendance continue to decline after this, a meeting will then be arranged with the Education Welfare Officer to explore further support and next steps.

## Lates

If you arrive to school after 08:30am, please go to the main school office, where your child's lateness will be recorded.

PLEASE BE MINDFUL THAT WE ARE HEADING INTO AUTUMN AND WINTER SO THERE WILL BE MORE CARS ON THE ROAD. PLEASE LEAVE EARLIER TO AVOID THE TRAFFIC.
