Homework & Learning at Home

Homework

We ask that all parents and carers spend time talking and supporting your child with their homework learning.

Reading

Children are asked to read every day (10-20 mins) to their parents or carer and record this in a Reading Record Book which will be sent home. In Key Stage One, physical books will be sent home alongside the Reading Planet online programme. In Key Stage Two, we will be introducing the Rising Stars 'Reading Planet Online' platform. This allows us to set and monitor reading at home. Prizes are won by the children according to the number of times they have read at home.

Year Group	Homework tasks
Nursery/ Reception	Phonics book linked to weekly sounds. Writing task linked to phonic sound Rising Stars online reading and physical reading books sent home
Year 1	Spellings and maths. Rising Stars online reading and physical reading books sent home
Year 2	Spellings and maths, Rising Stars online reading and physical reading books sent home
Year 3	Weekly spellings, maths and Reading planet online book. Termly topic homework project.
Year 4	Weekly spellings, maths and Reading Planet book and comprehension task. Termly topic homework project.
Year 5	Weekly spellings, maths and Reading Planet book and comprehension task. Termly topic homework project.
Year 6	Weekly spellings, Reading Planet book and comprehension. Comprehension /grammar sheet (focus on what they have learnt that week) and maths (focus on what they have learnt that week).

Homework is usually set on a Friday and handed in the following Wednesday.

Homework is set according to the children's academic ability and not according to their year group.
