Attendance - term time holidays

We value the support from all families in maintaining good punctuality and attendance. For those families looking to book cheaper holidays for 2026, please consider making use of our **extended May half term**.

A reminder that school will not authorise holidays taken during term time.

As some families have already been fined by the local authority for taking holidays during term time since September 2024, please see the information below regarding fines and prosecution for second and third periods of unauthorised absence.

From September 2024, the Department for Education announced national changes to penalty notices issued for unauthorised absence in term time. These changes came into effect on 19th August 2024. The changes to be aware of are:

- Penalty notices issued for offences that take place after 19 August 2024 will be charged at a new rate of £160 per parent per child. This can be paid at £80 if paid within 21 days.
- Any second penalty notice issued to the same parent for the same child within a rolling 3-year period will be issued at the rate of £160 to be paid within 28 days with no option for a discounted rate.
- The threshold at which a penalty notice **must** be considered is set at 10 sessions (equivalent to 5 days) of unauthorised absence within a rolling 10-school week period. This may include absences as a result of arriving late after the register closes. The 10 school weeks may span different terms or school years.
- A maximum of 2 penalty notices may be issued to a parent for the same child within a rolling 3-year period, so at the 3rd (or subsequent) offence(s) another course of action will need to be considered (such as prosecution or one of the other attendance legal interventions). This will apply to families who take term time holidays on multiple occasions and over multiple years.
