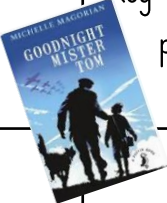


<u>English- Key Text</u> – Goodnight, Mr Tom. We will be writing a narrative based on Goodnight, Mr Tom by Michelle Magorian. This will give us learning opportunities about World War 2 which will help us with our History in Autumn 2. Have you ever stayed away from home? How did you feel? Key Vocabulary: Evacuee, Billeting Officer, Air-raid, Shell-shocked, Emaciated, Dilapidated.	<u>Maths - Focussed Units:</u> Place Value, Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division, Geometry, Statistics, Time (Y5) and Algebra (Y6). Secure times tables knowledge will be essential. Key Vocabulary: Sum, Difference, Partition, Part-part-whole, Exchange, Regroup, Bridging, Compensation, Digit, Sequence, Integer	<u>Science:</u> We will be learning all about different types of animals and looking closely at their life cycles. We will also be studying the physics of forces, including concepts such as gravity, friction and air resistance. Key Vocabulary: Plant, animal, bird, insect, habitat, season, change, growth, observe, measure, record, classify, life cycle.
<u>History</u> In History, children will learn about World War 2, focusing on the Blitz. They will sequence key events, explore historical sources, consider the impact on evacuees, and examine wartime propaganda and women's roles. .
