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| <p><u>Task 1: Maths</u></p> <p>Log on to your Numbots/TTRS account and complete at least 10 minutes of questions each day.</p> <p>Numbots: How many coins can you earn?</p> <p>TTRS: Can you 'level up'?</p> | <p><u>Task 2: Maths</u></p> <p>Practice arithmetic skills by completing Early Bird Maths questions each day. The questions and answers will be sent by email.</p> | <p><u>Task 3: Reading</u></p> <p>Read for 10 minutes, at least 3 times a week. This can be from any book that you have at home,</p> <p>Remember to ask an adult to sign your reading planner every time you read.</p> | <p><u>Task 4: Reading</u></p> <p>Log in to the reading cloud and blog about a story you have read.</p> <p>www.readingcloud.net</p> <p>Did you enjoy the story? | <p><u>Task 6: Phonics</u></p> <p>Access the free Phase 5 and Phase 6 phonics games on www.phonicsplay.co.uk</p> <p>Access some Year 2 grammar worksheets on twinkl, about sentences and conjunctions (and, but, because, if, so)</p> | <p><u>Task 7: Geography</u></p> <p>Use the internet to research and write at least 6 interesting facts about Amundsen and his Antarctic Expedition.</p> | <p><u>Task 8: Science</u></p> <p>Find and observe the wildlife in your garden, including plants, mini beasts, birds and other animals.</p> <p>Can you draw and label your garden habitat?</p> | <p><u>Task 9: PSHE</u></p> <p>Design a poster explaining how to stay safe online.</p> <p>This can be done by drawing on paper or completed in a word document.</p> <p>This should include 3 rules for keeping safe online.</p> | <p><u>Task 10:</u></p> <p>Write a story about your own animal character.</p> <p>Access educationquizzes.com click on KS1 and complete English and Maths quizzes.</p> |
