Use torches, mirrors, glow in the dark toys to enhance it. Discuss how it feels and how it is different to daylight.</p> <p>*Craft - make simple playdough together...</p> <p>1 cup Flour</p> <p>1/4 cup of Salt</p> <p>1 tea spoon Vegetable oil</p> <p>Food colouring</p> <p>Scent (if you want it to smell nice!)</p>
