<p>*Log on to your Numbots account and complete at least 5 minutes of questions each day.</p> <p>How many coins can you earn?</p>	<p>*Make collections of the same objects in different sizes (e.g. shoes, cutlery or toy animals) encourage the children to order by size using language of big/little, bigger/smaller, biggest/smallest, longer/shorter etc.</p> <p>*Use a ruler/measuring tape to measure the length of some items and record them in cm.</p> <p>*Play measuring games on Maths websites...</p>	<p>*Read for 10 minutes, at least 3 times a week. This can be from your school reading book as well as from other books of your choice.</p> <p>*Websites to try for more reading experiences</p> <p>www.freekidsbooks.org</p> <p>www.booktrust.org</p> <p>*Practise retelling your favourite story remembering the beginning, middle and end of the story. Can you include story language</p>	<p>*Focus on the Phase 5 'ie' sound. Watch Mr Thorne Phonics clip on Youtube</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Q49YSWKPyVo</p> <p>*Write a sentence containing the new 'ie' sound e.g. "I had a pie." Draw a picture too.</p> <p>*Play Phonics based games focussing on the 'ie' sound on...</p> <p>www.phonicsplay.co.uk</p> <p>Or</p> <p>www.phonicsbloom.co.uk</p> <p>*Watch the Alphablocks on iplayer.</p>	<p>*Knowledge and understanding of the world</p> <p>- Make a dark den using blankets/sheets/cushions. Use torches, mirrors, glow in the dark toys to enhance it. Discuss how it feels and how it is different to daylight.</p> <p>*Craft - make simple playdough together...</p> <p>1 cup Flour</p> <p>1/4 cup of Salt</p> <p>1 tea spoon Vegetable oil</p> <p>Food colouring</p>
