I know it's only our first week back, but already it's time to start applying for Reception places for September 2020, if you have a child who has a 4<sup>th</sup> birthday between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020. The deadline for applications to primary schools is **11.59 pm Wednesday, 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020.** Please apply even if an older brother or sister already attends Duke Street.

For children who have just started in our Year 6 class, the deadline for a high school place application is even earlier: **31**<sup>st</sup> **October 2019**. Applications are made online. Visit: www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools

## Dinner Money

The cost of school dinners for children from Year 3 to Year 6 is £2.20 per day, therefore dinner money due tomorrow is £22.00 for this week and next week (in advance as required by Lancashire County Council). If you have not applied for free school meals and feel you may be eligible, please contact Preston Education Office on 01772 531821. We will not be able to authorize dinners beyond next Friday for those children who are not on the list for free school meals and who have not paid any dinner money. Cash or cheque made payable to L.C.C. should be sent in on **FRIDAY MORNINGS**, in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name and class.

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are currently entitled to free school meals through the Government initiative, but if your child is in of these year groups and you are on the appropriate benefits, please apply for free school meals with Lancashire County Council so school can receive extra funding.
