<p>Step 1</p> <p>Log on to UCAS track at 8.15 and check your 'application status'.</p> <p>UCAS might freeze, might not update your status straight away so do not panic!</p>	<p>Step 2</p> <p>Collect A Level results from school. If you have no questions and your university place (or equivalent) is secure, then return resources to departments and fill in completed 'Destinations' form on departure.</p>	<p>Step 3</p> <p>If you have a question about reviewing your exam grades, speak to the teachers who are in school who will advise you and Mrs Gillham our exams officer.</p>
<p>Step 4</p> <p>If it appears you do not have a university place, speak with a member of the Sixth Form Team who are working upstairs with students in the IT3 and IT4.</p>	<p>Step 5</p> <p>If you need some help with speaking to a university, (for example you have missed out on your first-choice course) speak with a member of the Sixth Form Team in the SF office.</p>	<p>Step 6</p> <p>No matter your question or level of concern, do not leave the building without seeking advice or support from teachers in school.</p>
