

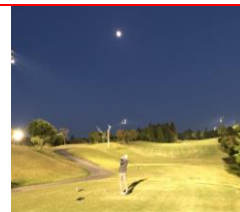

YEAR 13 – UCAS progress An impressive **173** applications have been made to UCAS. Anyone who wants to apply and hasn't already – needs to have their application completed and submitted by Monday 17th January. To clarify the process once you've paid and sent on the UCAS website:

- It shows up on our view of the UCAS website as ready for checking by your referee.
- Your referee will put you on the list (in submission time / date order) – to check your application. If there are errors or omissions – it will be returned to you. Make the changes and then 'pay and send' again. This does not require additional payments.
- Your referee will draw up a reference to support your ambitions and application.
- Your referee will contact you to organise an appointment – usually using the SF noticeboard.
- At this appointment you will read your reference and send your application to UCAS with your referee (Mrs Lennon / Mr Wilbraham).
