YEAR 13 – UCAS progress An impressive 173 applications have been made to UCAS. Anyone who wants to apply and hasn't already – needs to have their application completed and submitted by Monday 17th January. To clarify the process once you've paid and sent on the UCAS website:

- It shows up on our view of the UCAS website as ready for checking by your referee.
- Your referee will put you on the list (in submission time / date order) to check your application. If there are errors or omissions it will be returned to you. Make the changes and then 'pay and send' again. This does not require additional payments.
- Your referee will draw up a reference to support your ambitions and application.
- Your referee will contact you to organise an appointment usually using the SF noticeboard.
- At this appointment you will read your reference and send your application to UCAS with your referee (Mrs Lennon / Mr Wilbraham).
