- **Year 13** – You have your final mock exams when you return after the break. By the end of this week, it is important that you know what you need to do to prepare for the mock exams – 27th February – 3rd March (+ additional assessments in some subjects) - after the half term holidays. Preparation should include **content and exam technique**. The results of these exams will inform your university FIRM and INSURANCE choices.
- **National Apprenticeship Week last week** – lots of information / opportunities shared with you – any questions, come to the SF office and ask. Each week, look out for the email opportunities we send (often daily) and the weekly careers bulletin on our school website.
- **ROLE MODELS** – we rely on the support of Sixth Form students to show younger members of our community the right way to do things. Be mindful of this when you make choices regarding: uniform, the one-way system, no coats around corridors, no phones out (except in SFA).
- **Year 12 – REPORTS ISSUED LAST WEEK** – Intervention interviews continue this week. **Parents' Evening is 13th February** – your signed consent forms identifying entry for external AS exams must be handed in to the SFO by **Tuesday 14th February – morning break – at the latest**.
- **Show your intellectual journey**. Explore super curricular opportunities: explore/investigate your subjects, beyond the A-Level classroom. This type of reading and research will help those of you in Y13 who have interviews on the horizon or those in Y12 starting/developing thinking on next steps, especially on what university courses may be right for you.
