  - You will have the opportunity of a meeting with Mrs Lennon or Mr Wilbraham shortly to discuss any queries you might have regarding this important decision.
- **Show your intellectual journey.** Explore super curricular opportunities: explore/investigate your subjects, beyond the A-Level classroom. This type of reading and research will help those of you in Y13 who have interviews on the horizon or those in Y12 starting/developing thinking on next steps, especially on what university courses may be right for you.
