1. **Please return any textbooks and your locker key.** Please put your name on a piece of paper inside the cover of returned books and put your locker key in an envelope with your name, Form and locker number.
2. **Collect your results.** Results will be available on tables in the Atrium, organised alphabetically by surname. Find your table and collect your envelope. If you left any personal possessions in your locker, they will be under this table with your name on, for collection. Any items not collected will be disposed of appropriately.
