Before Results Day

- ☑ Engage with any applicant information sent by your chosen universities – there may be 'hotline' numbers on there – make a note of them.

On Results Day

- ☑ If you have applied for university, check UCAS Track – normally updates at approximately 8.00am.
- ☑ To collect your GCE A Level results – come to the Atrium from 8.00am.
- ☑ If you require further information / guidance, come up to the Sixth Form Area. IT3 & IT4 will also be available for exploring Clearing options. We will be on hand to support you. We will be here Friday 19th August too.
- ☑ Get your Student Finance and accommodation finalised.
- ☑ Hand in your 'Destinations' information.
- ☑ **Keep in touch – we are still here to help you.**

What if I can't attend?

- ☑ If you know in advance, please give Ms Gillham (Exams) an SAE or a letter authorising someone else to collect
- ☑ If you are unable to collect your results you can authorise someone else to collect them with a note / letter (must be signed by the student).
- ☑ If you have applied to university – check track – if you have not been successful, start exploring your options in Clearing as soon as possible.
