Virtual School Exchange

In November 2019 the school began to forge links with a school in the Netherlands, the Christelijk Lyceum Zeist in the south east of the country. The aim was to hold visits between the two schools but of course the impact of the pandemic prohibited this. We are however hopeful that some form of exchange might take place in the 2021-2022 academic year.

Ahead of any potential exchange programme we're holding a "virtual exchange" between students from the two schools on Thursday 22nd April. Year 9 pupils who wish to take part will spend periods 1 and 2 working on a series of projects with their counterparts in the Dutch school via video conferencing. Students will be expected to catch up on missed work from the two lessons they will miss.

Please note that participation in this event is not linked to students being involved in any future exchange programme.
