It means it comes to us at school and your referee will pick you up (they'll communicate and set up a time for you to review your form, predicted grades and reference before it goes off to your universities).</p> <p>Keep communicating in PHE, especially after Tuesday's Baker Event, as to whether you want to apply for an apprenticeship. Communicate with Mr Everett to ensure you are on his Teams group for this pathway.</p> <p>Y12: Departments will be telling you how you'll be assessed in class by the end of W/B 9 December.
