How do languages help you in your future career?

Learning languages gives you transferable skills; you develop the ability to think creatively, to forge connections between communities, to translate across cultures and identities. Languages give us a sense of who we are and allow us to express and explore ourselves.

What skills and knowledge will you gain from the course and how is it taught?

The GCSE course in French/ German/ Spanish aims to develop the ability to understand and use the language effectively as a means of practical communication and imaginative expression. Emphasis is placed on the development of an understanding of the grammar, structure and vocabulary of the language. Combined with study of the culture and civilisation of French/ German/ Spanish speaking countries. Throughout the course, equal importance is placed on the four language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) and students are exposed to a wide range of authentic language materials.
