Headteacher – Governor by virtue of office

Local Authority Governor – nominated by the LA and appointed by the Governing Body Parent Governor – elected by the parent body

Staff Governor – elected by school staff

Student Associate Governors - two, Year 12 students - elected annually by their peers. Student Governors serve a one-year term of office but have no voting rights
