To register and to make an appointment you will need the following information:

- Your title, as held on the school system i.e. Miss, Ms, Mrs, Mr, Dr, etc...
- Your surname, as held on the school system.
- The date of birth of your child.

The person who can make the appointments will be the person listed on the school's system has having parental responsibility and living at the same address as the student. We ask that only one person make the appointments. If you find you cannot make appointments, please contact the school. You can then share your appointments with another party meaning, for example, one parent can be in their home and another join the appointments from another household or place of work.

This will allow you to register, log on and then make appointments with your child's teachers.

The appointment system will be accessible from 10.00am on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> January and will close at 12.00 p.m. on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> January. You can join the parents' evening and make appointments on any internet enabled device such as a smart phone, tablet or computer.
