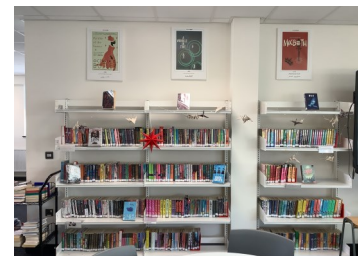


THE MARY SHELLEY LIBRARY AT EALING FIELDS

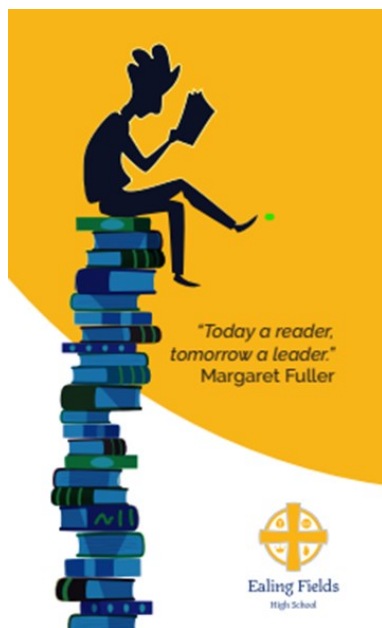
Create a reading routine and build a reading habit. We appreciate that reading might feel overwhelming at times for some students. Why not read little and often? Encourage reading while you are in the middle of doing something else – a recipe while cooking, a newspaper article while waiting for the bus, directions to a new place.

All reading is reading. Match coverage or reports, blogs or reviews are all good way into reading. Follow your child's interests, whether that be fashion, music or sport. Online reading is still reading. Encourage your child to read from a range of resources to inspire confidence.

Encourage, support and celebrate your child's reading. Don't make reading a chore. And re-reading is fine. If your child has a favourite book, let them enjoy going back to it.
