#### **Finances**

We have had a successful bounce back post-pandemic:

- £7,005 fundraising by Autumn Half Term
- Total raised in 2021 £11,810.92 (PTSA year is calendar year)
- EF PTSA funding per pupil as the school expands is still above average.
- Costs were below 50%.

#### Past projects funded:

School library (£5,000), Wellness centre (£5,000) 3D printer (£500)

£1,300 raised so for this year (2022) – Quiz, Sports Day, Student Comedy

The Laser Tag event was unfortunately cancelled owing to communication issues – but will be postponed. As offsite and playground locations are not an option, perhaps it is best to this event keep to Autumn Term as works well in dark in the performance centre.

# Potential funding projects/requests:

Outdoor chess set £1,615 Debating Chamber in Oratory (folly) Stage for Performance Centre Department Grants (£500 each department)

Request for Outdoor chess set passed - all present in favour.
