



## Ealing Fields High School

Dear Parent/Carer,

The Ealing Fields Governing Body have established a School Fund, to supplement government funding that doesn't always stretch to pay for school trips and other extras that make such a difference to our students. The School fund is made up entirely of voluntary financial donations from parents and is held in a separately administered bank account.

Each year the school Governors decide how best to spend this money and our experience here at Ealing Fields, is that regular generous giving by parents is essential if the school is to thrive for the benefit of all students. Last year, for example, the school fund contributed 10K towards books for the new library, and this year we plan to contribute towards improvements in the Performance Centre to include staging, better stage lighting, sound systems and curtains, similar to the facilities at Twyford, which will enhance not just drama performances but other aspects of the wider curriculum.
