**Re: Year 7 Getting to Know you Day- Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> September 2026**

Every year we are delighted to run the year 7 Getting to Know you Day. The activity day takes place at Longridge Activity Centre in Marlow. The trip allows students from different primary schools to get to know each other in an informal and enjoyable setting, as well as developing their teamwork and problem-solving skills. We will be running this trip for all year 7 pupils on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> September 2026. The cost of the trip will be confirmed early next academic year but is likely to be around £37. This year, the PTSA have kindly contributed £1696 towards the total cost of this trip. Students who qualify for Pupil Premium funding will be able to use their pupil premium allowance to fully cover this cost.

Students will need to be at school at 8:15am, in time for an 8:30am departure by coach and will return to school at the end of the school day. Students will be allowed to carry their school-approved phones to notify you when they are nearing school. **They will not be allowed a smart phone.**

Students will be taking part in outdoor activities and must dress accordingly for this. A kit list has been provided. Students will also need to provide their own lunch.

Please complete the Microsoft form to indicate that your child will be attending the trip and that they can swim 25m (please note your child will not be swimming on this trip. There will only be one 'on-water' activity (dragon boating) and this does not require your child to enter the water). Nevertheless, it is important for us to know if your child is a non-swimmer. All students will be given the opportunity to take part in the dragon boating activity unless you have emailed [edjones@ealingfields.org.uk](mailto:edjones@ealingfields.org.uk) to inform us otherwise.
