

COVID 19 Catch Up Premium

The first tranche of catch up funding, to pay for interventions to help students catch up with learning missed during the closures in the year, has been received. Interventions are being implemented.

Ealing Fields received c.£52,000.

Areas identified where pupil progress has been impacted:

We have identified catch-up in English in the upper school as our top priority as they have been some of our weaker results in the past so most at-risk from lockdown. Also disadvantaged students in Years 7-11 as access to quality home-learning environments has been harder.

Proposed use of catch up funding:

- Additional teaching group in English Language in Year 11.
- Additional teaching group in English Literature in Year 11.
- Additional teaching group in English in Year 10.
- Year 11 catch-up classes before and after school.
- Year 7-11 study club offering year group specific after-school study groups for off track & at risk students.
- Pupil Premium raising achievement groups targeting those most affected by lockdown.

The effect of this expenditure will be monitored through our standard pupil progress monitoring systems, with particular attention being paid to reading ages.
