



**KEY VOCABULARY**

**saviour**

a person who saves someone from harm or difficulty – for Christians, Jesus is a saviour who saved them from the things they had done wrong

**inspire**

to fill someone with a feeling or idea – Christians are inspired by Jesus to do good things

**humble**

being humble is the opposite of showing off – when you are humble you help others before yourself and you do not boast

**symbol**

a picture used to represent something

**messiah**

a person who is considered to be the saviour – Christians think of Jesus as the Messiah, sent by God to save them

The Bible tells stories about Jesus that show he was humble – these stories act as lessons for Christians

Jesus washed his disciples feet



Jesus shared bread and wine with his disciples



**Symbols linked to Jesus in Christianity**

cross



the cross reminds Christians of Jesus' sacrifice – some Christians will choose to wear the symbol of the cross.

dove



often used as a symbol of peace and purity, the dove can also represent the Holy Spirit

bread



this is also a symbol of generosity and sharing for many Christians – Jesus shared bread with his disciples

fish



early Christians used a fish symbol to identify themselves – the Bible tells Christians that Jesus performed a miracle to share fish with 5,000 people
