
Premier Sports Afterschool Clubs





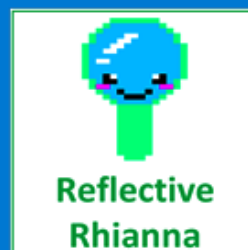
