## Highlight Larwood:

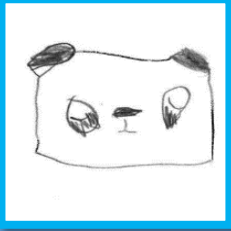

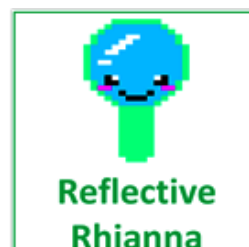
