Larwood Class: Cambridge Trip: 6th February 2025

Linked to our learning across the curriculum this term, we have been planning an **educational visit to Cambridge**, which will entail a visit to **Cambridge Central Mosque** and **The Fitzwilliam Museum**.

The trip will be on **Thursday 6th February, within the school day**. The coach will depart at 09:00am and return to school at 15:00pm (approximately). Therefore, normal drop-off and collection times apply.

The visit will include a study of museum exhibits, linked to current, future and previous learning across the Year 3 and 4 History curriculum. We will also have the opportunity to consolidate our learning in RE as we visit the mosque, exploring the gardens and prayer hall and marvelling at the impressive eco-friendly architecture.

Children will be required to wear their school uniform. Although there are times we will be the only group using the facilities, there will also be times where we are mixed with the general public. It is therefore in the interest of safety that your child attends in their uniform. Due to the fact that there will be some walking involved, **trainers or other appropriate, comfortable footwear are permitted.**

If you would like to book a school packed lunch, please let the school office know by **Thursday 29th January at the very latest**, otherwise children will need to bring their own packed lunch with them. **Please bring packed lunches in a disposable carrier bag.** This will mean that children do not need to carry anything around with them throughout the day. No backpacks are required. Your child should only attend with their lunch and a water bottle.

The cost of the trip will be £18.00 per pupil. However, **FOES have kindly offered to contribute £10 per pupil** bringing **the cost to £8.00 per pupil** – thank you, FOES; we really appreciate this.

Payment and permission for this trip is made via Arbor from Friday 24th January. The deadline for payment is Wednesday 5th February. If you have concerns over meeting the cost of the trip, please make contact with Mr Abbs to discuss your situation further.

Do not send in any money with your child. There will be no opportunities to spend any.

Educational visits are a great opportunity for children to learn together, outside the classroom and enhance their school experience. It would be fantastic to see all of Larwood Class in attendance.
