First Day Back

Lovely to welcome children back into school – old and new. We kick- started our first day with a Year 1 – 6 assembly with a reminder of our school rules, core values and expectations for pupil behaviour. We focussed on all the rewards, awards and incentives we offer that supports a culture of positive behavioural choices (around 20), before reminding children of our systems for sanctioning (including new systems – reference to new behaviour policy previously sent).

Our pupils are aware that you will now be notified by email/SMS if they are involved in a behaviour incident that meets this threshold. Similarly, our pupils were excited to learn that – although the bar has been raised for receiving a single House Point e.g for excellent demonstration of one of our Core Values – that parents will be notified via their new Arbor account. We hope this provides real meaning and an opportunity for you to reinforce the praise at home.

This really excited our pupils. They have previously told us: 'we like it when you say nice things about us, and to our parents'.

Meanwhile, children in Year R were busy settling into their new classroom and routine. Well done Year R. A fabulous start.
