<u>Genies:</u> Genies have been reading The Gingerbread Man, they retold the story using puppets and wearing masks. We also made salt dough gingerbread men. We had a snowy and cold afternoon in the woods but found it lots of fun! The Genies have also been practising taking turns this week when plaving matching games.

<u>**Pixies</u>** This week we have read The Gingerbread Man, we have been retelling the story with some amazing actions and can tell the story independently without even looking at the book! In Phonics our new sound is P and in Maths we have been making repeating patterns. Nativity practices are going well and we can't wait for you to see it, Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> December at 9.30am.</u>

<u>Sprites:</u> Sprites have been learning how to bake bread this week. Just like Little Red Hen, we kneaded the dough and baked our loaves in the oven... yum! We've taken the recipe home so we can explain the steps to our grown ups. In Maths we've been working out 1 more or 1 less than a small number.

<u>Elves</u> Nativity season is well upon us, and we are practising hard. On our class Facebook there is a link to our songs we are singing. So please feel free to sing to your hearts content at home. In phonics, we have done a full week concentrating on our tricky words. The children are finding it hard to make these stick in their memory but we are doing all we can at school to help them. In maths we have been looking at taking away and in topic our focus has shifted to the geography of Whitby and makina our own keu for a map.

<u>Phoenixes:</u> Year 2 have been writing diary entries in literacy. They have continued to develop their mental maths skills. In geography they have been learning about map coordinates. The Nativity rehearsals are looking good. The children have been working hard to learn the songs and dance routines.

<u>Unicorns</u> In maths, we have been mastering inverse. We have produced an amazing double page on our Antarctica research. In project work we looked at what we would need to wear on a polar expedition.... next time it snows, we can help you all!

<u>Centaurs:</u> The children have been working hard writing adventure stories this week all based on a voyage through the digestive system! They have also worked really well in PE looking at different jumping movements on apparatus in gymnastics. In maths they have continued to master their times table facts and are using these really well to help them work on multiplication and division questions. Some of us are now looking at multiplication with carrying too.

<u>Griffins</u> In project this week year 5 have looked at the movement and phases of the moon. We also completed our reports on our chosen planet and typed them up on the computer. In maths we have continued to compare and order fractions. In French we have been practicing saying our birthday and have written a birthday card. We finally finished our wooden truss bridges! All children have worked so well in their teams.

Gnomes <sup>©</sup> This week we have focused on the nursery rhyme 'Row, Row, Row your boat', we learnt actions to the song and had boats in the water tray. We have continued looking at the book 'Car, Car, Truck, Jeep' and have looked at some real pictures of different vehicles from the book. We have also been lucky enough to explore the snow in our sensory tray, we learnt that snow melts when it gets warm!

<u>**Dragons**</u> This week in year 6, we have looked at shipwrecks in Whitby and used them for inspiration for our own ghosts stories that we are starting to write. In Maths, we have consolidated our fraction knowledge and understanding. During PE, we have been doing gymnastics and also working on how to play as a team.

**Pegasus** This week our literacy group are finishing off our Beegu work and writing a book review. We are looking forward to the next few week and diving into some more festive texts. In our social group we have been talking about meeting new people and what to say. In our maths group we have been working on sharing and grouping and the children are looking forward to continuing their DT project next week! Well done Pegasus!

Well, we have officially made it to December and what a week it has been! The snowy weather has certainly made things interesting, seeing the pure joy the snow brings the children really is lovely! We are sorry we have had to cancel clubs this week, but we are sure you will understand that it is absolutely the right call for the safety of staff and children.
