In Maths we've been looking at ways to represent 4 and 5. In our Jigsaw time we have thought about what we are good at.

Elves This week we have continued looking at James Cooks early life and what he did in Staithes and in Whitby around the age of 17 and 18. We have also started to create a timeline of his early life. In maths we have been working on number bonds to 10 and addition. All the children have loved dressing up today and enjoyed the Rock Star event. :-)

Phoenixes: In year 2 we have started their local history and geography project. They have been learning the songs for the Key Stage One Nativity. In Maths , they have continued to develop their understanding of place value. The have also continued to explore and master a range of addition and subtraction strategies.
