<u>Genies:</u> We have read stories about The Large Family and talked about our own families. We like to look at the pictures of our families and name them. During singing time we have sung Three Little Ducks, counting up until Mother Duck has 3 ducks. In Squiggle we have enjoyed making marks in the tuff spot with shaving foam and paint.

<u>Pixies</u> This week we have started Rhyme Time and our rhyme of the week is Miss Molly had a Dolly. We are learning to retell the rhyme, recognise rhyming words, identify words beginning with same sound and listen to sounds associated with the rhyme. We are also being very good Doctors, making sure all our dollies are well! In Phonics we have continued matching words beginning with the same sound as our name. In Maths we have been matching Numicon and different size handprints

**Sprites:** This week we've been talking about where we live and how maps show people where things are. In the woods we worked together to build mini dens. In Maths we've been comparing length and mass using words like 'lighter/heavier', 'longest/shortest'. We've learnt another 4 sounds in Phonics and we've done so well reading words on our own. It was lovely to let parents know how brilliantly everyone's settled into full time school!

<u>Elves</u> The children have really enjoyed the start of our new topic 'materials'. We have explored the difference between the objects name and what it is made from and we have also been able to sort objects too. It has been super practical and hands on. We have used our chunking up method in phonics to help us to read longer words and have looked at finding 1 more and 1 less in maths. Brilliant work this week well done Year 1

<u>Phoenixes:</u> In writing we have been investigating words in a text. We have composed a group and individual poem. We have been working hard to improve our reading. In maths we have been learning about addition fact families. In science we have been learning about respiration.

<u>Unicorns</u> This week, Year 3 have been investigating if certain materials are transparent, translucent or opaque and the resulting shadows which may or may not form. We have also been learning our 3 and 4 tomes tables, while looking closely at adding and subtracting 1, 10 and 100 from given numbers.

<u>Centaurs:</u> This week we continued our journey through Tudor times by looking at the 6 wives of Henry VIII and have been putting together fact files using Chatter Pics to bring the Queens back to life! We have been honing our skills in column addition with carrying and exchanging and continue to amaze at the swimming pool too! We have also thought about tolerance and respect both online and in person. Thank you to everyone who came to parent's evening, I'll catch up with those who couldn't make it in the coming weeks.

<u>**Griffins**</u> We have continued with the Industrial Revolution. In music we listened to Stomp and created our own rhythmic compositions using found objects to reflect the sounds of the industrial revolution. In writing we are writing a persuasive letter to the Government to put a new law in place to stop the child labour in the factories. All children have done a great first draft!
