Frequently Asked Question.

Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you for all your questions about the return to school.

Here are a list of the most frequently asked questions and answers to them. If you have any more questions, please don't hesitate to ask.

Q. Does my child have to go to school?

A. Yes. School will be fully open to all pupils. The expectation is that all pupils return to school when the term starts on the 8th of September.

Q. Can children bring Packed lunches?

A. In Key Stage 2 children can bring packed lunches, from September there will be a choice at lunchtimes. Therefore, we would like all children in Reception/Year 1 and Year 2 to have free school meals rather than bring in a packed lunch. If Obviously, if there is a medical reason for bringing a packed lunch in those year groups then we will be happy to discuss this with parents and where necessary make adaptions.

Q. Can children bring in their own equipment?

A. No. Children will be provided with the equipment they need in class.

Q. Can Children bring in their own Sanitizer?

A. No unless they have pre-arranged with us for medical reasons. Each class and space will have its own sanitizer that is at NHS specifications to reduce risk of spreading the virus.

Q. Can Children bring book bags?

A. We will be sorting and sending reading books home very quickly. Bookbags are the best way to do this, however children often fill the bags with all sorts of other stuff. We request book bags are only used for books. In Reception children will be provided with clear plastic reading bags.

Q. Can children bring PE kit in?

A. Children should wear their PE Kit on the day they have PE. As PE may be outdoors, they may need tracksuit bottoms or leggings. We request that they wear their school jumper over the top of the PE kit.

Q, Can children bring their own waterbottle?

Children will be allowed to bring their own water bottle to school, however water will be available in class. Can names please be written on the water bottles.

Q. Will Breakfast/ after school Club provide food?

A. Breakfast/After-school club will provide a simple breakfast and afterschool snack. Where possible places must be pre-booked. You can book a place by ringing the office the day before. Normal costs will resume.

Q. How do I book Breakfast and after school Club?

A. You can phone school the day before to book a place, or you can email school. You will be able to book by phone, just contact the office this week. Those parents who have already contacted school are already booked. Normal charges will apply.

Q. Do the children have to wear uniform everyday?

A. We would expect children to wear uniform to school. Children should wear sensible shoes/trainers they can run around and play in. You don't have to change uniform everyday though it is preferable if it can be changed a couple of times a week.

Q. Can my parents or a family member pick up my child?

A. Yes as long as this clearly communicated with school by the parent/carer. It is not acceptable for a child to tell the teacher that this is the case.

Q will children's classes have to close?

A. Whilst children will not be asked to isolate if there is an individual case in their class, if there are multiple cases in a class we may be required to close the class and go to a remote learning model depending on advice received if it is an outbreak.
