Characteristics of Learning

The curriculum is set around the following **learning characteristics**:

- Playing and exploring
- Active learning
- Creating and thinking critically

Playing and Exploring Through play our children explore and develop learning experiences which help them make sense of the world. They practise and build up ideas, and learn how to control themselves and understand the need for rules. They communicate with others as they investigate and solve problems. They express fears and relive anxious experiences in controlled and safe situations.

Active Learning Active learning occurs when children are motivated and interested. Children need to have some independence and control over their learning. As children develop their confidence, they learn to make decisions. This provides children with a sense of satisfaction as they take ownership of their learning.

Creativity and Thinking Critically

'When children have opportunities to play with ideas in different situations and with a variety of resources they discover connections and come to new and better understandings and ways of doing things.
