welcome back to a new school year! We hope you had a lovely time over the Summer with your family and friends.

It has been nice to see some sunny weather since we have arrived back to school and the children in both Nursery and Reception have particularly enjoyed spending time in our outdoor environment. Lots of exploring, den building and stream paddling!

We are excited to get started this year, so would like to take the opportunity to remind you all about our Stay and Play sessions. It gives parents & carers the opportunity to come and join the setting with your child. In Nursery and Reception, this is <u>every Thursday between 8.45-9.30am (12-12.30pm – Afternoon Nursery</u>). During this time, we encourage you to come and play alongside your child and you will see them playing with both adults and their peers. You will find out how specific activities and skills are taught through our play-based curriculum and have the opportunity to talk to teaching staff. We provide different themes and curriculum focuses each week, giving parents and carers a broad spectrum of ideas and knowledge. Please ask staff if you have any questions about these sessions.

At Easterside, we value the importance of a regular and consistent routine, particularly when children first start school. It has been lovely to see how well the children have settled into our classes and we have already noticed how they are learning new skills and following our rules and routines.

<u>Attendance to school is essential</u> and we recommend that you continue to promote this to your child so that important learning opportunities are not missed. We monitor attendance and punctuality across school on a daily basis ensuring consistency for all. <u>Please be reminded that the school hours are now 8.45am-3.15pm</u>

We will continue to keep you updated - this will be through the school APP and website. Look out for us sharing your child's achievements on "Marvellous Me" too!
