Our **Headstarters** joined with **Mr Elliott** our Chair of Governors on Friday to interview groups of children from Y1 to Y6. They discussed 'Friendship Week' and what the children had learnt. Children discussed topics such as:- One kind word; friendship; anti-bullying; types of bullying; trusted adults; discrimination;

restorative conversations; mental health and the nine protected characteristics of the Equality Act.
