<u>English</u>

Our daily English sessions will focus on the application of phonics, sentence types and punctuation through a range of writing opportunities. This half term our writing genres will include; a narrative, diary and letter. The Year 1 children will be developing their independence at writing simple sentences. The Year 2 children will be extending their writing using conjunctions, expanded noun phrases and a wider range of punctuation.

<u>Maths</u>

During Maths, we will be developing the children's problem solving, reasoning and fluency. The children will be becoming confident with number and place value. They will learn to identify numbers represented in different ways, how to partition in different ways and order and compare different amounts. KS1 will also be taking part in the Mastering Number programme which will be an additional 10 minutes every day to develop their number fluency.
