Find out about significant men and women of the Mayan civilization. Write a biography about their lives.

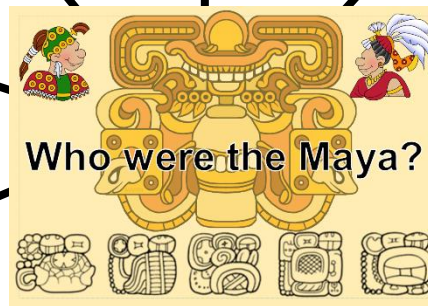
Find out any 10 facts about the Mayan era and order them in a timeline according to date.
