



Dear Parents / Carers,

You will have recently received a letter about some changes to how we support children's behaviour within school using a **restorative approach**. As part of this we are also changing some of the terminology we use within our current behaviour policy. The term 'isolation' currently used for one of our consequences will no longer be used and instead you will hear us use the term '**reflection time**'. Children will be directed to reflection time when staff feel that the child/ren need to reflect on **what has happened – who is has affected – and what needs to happen next**. At KS1 this will be done partly with an adult through a restorative conversation. At KS2 the child will spend some time in a partner classroom, completing one of our new 'reflection sheets'. This will then be followed up with an adult before the child re-joins the classroom; and again through a restorative conversation the adult will help the child to reflect on what has happened and the impact it has had on others. As I shared in my recent letter, the new behaviour policy will be shared with all parents later on this academic year.
