Support for pupils was provided through the funding of:

Curriculum focus of PPG spending

To support pupils at Easterside Academy all Pupil Premium funding was targeted at three main areas of the curriculum; Reading, Writing and Maths to raise attainment and improve rates of progress.

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

- 100% of children eligible for Pupil Premium at Easterside Academy made **expected progress** in Reading, Writing and Maths at the end of KS2.
- 64% of children eligible for Pupil Premium at Easterside Academy made **more than expected progress** in Reading at the end of KS2. This is an increase from last year.
- 36% of children eligible for Pupil Premium at Easterside Academy made **more than expected progress** in Writing at the end of KS2. This is an increase from last year.
- 43% of children eligible for Pupil Premium at Easterside Academy made **more than expected progress** in Maths at the end of KS2. This is a slight decrease from last year.
- 10% of children attained a Level 6 for Maths. These are the first Level 6's at Easterside Academy.
- 70% of children passed the Year 1 phonic screening test and 100% of Year 2 children moving into KS2 also passed.
- EYFS 'Good Level of Development' rose from 33% to 55% this academic year.
- At KS1 the % of children attaining the higher levels at 2B+ and 2A rose.
- Several families across the school benefited from advice and support from the Care Team and The Bungalow Partnership.
- There has been an improvement this year on attendance and punctuality. The % for attendance at the end of the academic year was 95.5% (not including Reception) and 95.3% (including Reception). This is in line with National Average.
